1. What is the research study about?

You are invited to take part in this research study. The research study aims to understand the experiences of and attitudes towards learning to swim, among participants of the NSW Learn to Swim for At-Risk Communities Program. The research will also look at the impact of program participation on skill attainment. You have been invited because you are enrolling a child in this program.

2. Who is conducting this research?

The study is being carried out by the following researchers: Dr Amy Peden, School of Population Health. Research Funder: This research is being funded by Royal Life Saving New South Wales, using funding from the NSW Government Office of Sport.

3. Inclusion/Exclusion Criteria

Before you decide to participate in this research study, we need to ensure that it is ok for you to take part. The research study is looking recruit people who meet the following criteria:

- Your child is enrolled in Program 1 Regional Children;
- Your child resides in a regional area of New South Wales
- Your child is aged 3-14 years
- You give consent to participate in the research

4. Do I have to take part in this research study?

Participation in any research study is voluntary. If you do not want to take part, you do not have to. If you decide you want to take part in the research study, you will be asked to:

- Read the information carefully (ask questions if necessary);
- Complete the online questionnaire.

5. What does participation in this research require, and are there any risks involved?

If you decide to take part in the research study, we will ask you to complete two online surveys, one before your child participates in the program and one after. The surveys will ask you questions about learning to swim. Each survey should take approximately 10 minutes to complete. The two surveys will be linked together using a combination of your child's date of birth, home postcode and gender which you will provide on each of the two surveys. Linkage of the datasets will be conducted only by Royal Life Saving Society – NSW solely and will not be shared with any other personnel including CI Amy Peden.

There are no costs associated with participating in this research project, nor will you be paid. However, if you complete each survey you will have the opportunity to enter the draw to win one of five Royal Life Saving NSW gift packs valued at \$100. You will be notified via email if you have won. Any information provided to enter the prize draw will not be linked with the main survey.

There are no risks associated with participating in this research beyond inconvenience.

6. What are the possible benefits to participation?

We hope to use information we get from this research study to benefit others who may participate in future learn to swim programs.

7. What will happen to information about me?

Submission of the online questionnaire is an indication of your consent. By clicking 'yes' to the question asking 'Do you give your consent to participate in this survey?' you are providing your permission for the research team to collect and use information about you for the research study.

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The research team will store the data collected from you for this research project for:

- A minimum of 5 years after the publication of the research results;

The information about you will be stored in a:

- Non-identifiable format where your identify will be unknown.

8. How and when will I find out what the results of the research study are?

The research team intend to publish and/ report the results of the research. All Information will be published in a way that will not identify you.

9. What if I want to withdraw from the research study?

If you do consent to participate, you may withdraw at any time. You can do this by closing the questionnaire. If you withdraw from the research, we will destroy any information that has already been collected. Once you have submitted the questionnaire however, we will not be able to withdraw your responses as the questionnaire is anonymous.

The information you provide is personal information for the purposes of the Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998 (NSW). You have the right of access to personal information held about you by the University, the right to request correction and amendment of it, and the right to make a complaint about a breach of the Information Protection Principles as contained in the PPIP Act.
